The composition consists of three parts:

A. Each musician, starting from a different point in the landscape, 'collects' multiphonics by each of the sculptures. They use the multiphonics ad lib, mixing, combining as they walk from sculpture to sculpture.

B. The two muscians are now together. They perform the score part B three times. First time, as written. Second time, using tremolos, vibrato, etc., ad lib exploring the possibilities of each multiphonic.

C. The musicians split, continuing their individual walk from A, in different directions. Now, they 'lay back' the multiphonics in the landscape, by combining/mixing lesser and lesser, until they have said goodbye to all seven multiphonics.

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
